This is in response to the 2022 Conference Advisory Action that the trustees' Literature Committee revised the pamphlet "Do You Think You're Different?" to update the stories to represent greater diversity. The Trustees' Literature Committee requested consideration be given to stories from multicultural populations, stories from A.A. members whose experience reflects multiple factors, and those from diverse populations not addressed in other current A.A. literature. Highlights from The Quarterly Report

 Potential facilitators are being considered. The inventory will take place during the January
 Board weekend and a final report and presentation will take place during the 74th
 General Service Conference.
- A progress report from the Trustees' Literature Committee included a draft of the updated pamphlet, with a new title, "Black in A.A. Experience, Strength and Hope."
- With the addition of an Editorial Project Manager in March, AAWS has been able to return nearly 100 items that were stalled back into production
- Grapevine's podcast now has more than 530,000 downloads
