## International Convention Update

While we are still 9 months away from International Convention 2025 in Vancouver, Canada, excitement is high and planning is well under way! For those that are making the journey for the big event, you may have experienced some frustration in the registration and housing booking process. The team that is coordinating this event has been hard at work processing emails and feedback received from members of the Fellowship. Some of the tips they have shared are:

- If you could register but could not book housing at the time of registration, check back in your registration record frequently. They are adding rooms to the inventory and alternative housing options. Experience also shows that some members who initially booked housing will cancel their bookings closer to the event, freeing up some housing options.
- If you have not yet registered, it is not too late!
- There are also options for members who cannot attend the in-person event. These include a live-stream virtual session program or an anonymity-protected video after the event.
