Plain Language Big Book <u>Updates</u>

The Plain Language Big Book: A Tool for Reading Alcoholics Anonymous was released on November 1, 2024, and has been in high demand. It is bittersweet for those of us involved in the Conference process of review and approval. We were dismayed to find that the book had been printed without following the guidance that was provided in the Advisory Action passed at the 74th General Service Conference when the book was approved. Specifically, "replace the references to 'addiction' and 'addicted' with language related to alcoholism". This matter has been brought to the attention of the General Service Board, and we are awaiting a response about corrective measures. We are also hoping to better understand how the this guidance occurred as the Conference speaks as the collective group conscience of the Fellowship. More information will be shared as it becomes available.

While this is explored and corrected, the book remains a useful tool to make our program more accessible. More information on how to purchase it is available on aa.org. You can also get more information by reviewing this announcement or this press release.

General Service Board Updates

Updated Financial Reports: As he has over the past couple of years, the General Manager of GSO, Bob W., sent out a gratitude letter to the Fellowship in early November. This letter contains some updated information regarding contributions and the current financial condition of Alcoholics Anonymous World Services. If you have not yet read the memo from Bob W., you can click here to read it. For more detailed information on the finances of the 3 Boards, you can view the unaudited Quarter 3 AAWS/GSB and Grapevine Board Financial Statements here. Inflation and costs associated with the printing and distribution of our literature continue to play a role on the financial health of AA. While there has been some improvement in 2024, with the increase in the price of some literature for the first time in 10 years in addition to the slow-down of inflation, sales margins have not returned to what they were before the COVID pandemic and are unlikely to do so. The increase in contributions along with decreases in spending have helped to move the financial outlook in the right direction. For a more detailed explanation of the financial reporting and budgeting process, please see the "Inside A.A. Finances" section of the latest issue of Box 4-5-9. This is a regular column authored by one of the Class A (non-alcoholic) Trustees on the General Service Board, Kevin Prior. He currently serves as the chair of the Finance Committee and helps to break down A.A. finances so they are more understandable for the Fellowship.

Quarterly Statements: Updated Quarterly Statements recently went out to DCMs from GSO. These statements report on the contributions received from groups by district. An error in the reporting system has led to some inaccuracies and will not be
